CALIFORNIA INSTRUCTIONAL QUALITY COMMISSION

Every year, the California State Board of Education (SBE) appoints one incoming high school senior to serve on the Instructional Quality Commission (IQC) for a one-year term. The student member functions as a regular voting member of the IQC. The information below explains the application and selection processes, and contains a copy of the application. Please feel free to copy and distribute it to any student who might be interested. The deadline to submit applications is Monday, September 30, 2024.

About the 2025-2026 Student Member

Eligibility

Any student who is a California resident, enrolled in a California public high school, and who will be enrolled in good standing in the twelfth grade in the 2025–2026 school year may apply.

Term of Office

The Student Member will serve a one-year term from September 1, 2025, through June 30, 2026.

Time Requirements

The estimated time commitment required for the Student Member will be a one-day orientation in January, and at least two consecutive school days every other month to attend regular IQC meetings, held in Sacramento. If needed, additional subcomittee meetings may be scheduled. All of these meetings require preparation time to study the agenda materials and prepare feedback in advance.

Expenses Paid

The Student Member will serve without pay. All authorized travel costs related to IQC meetings (e.g., transportation, lodging, meals) are reimbursed in accordance with state regulations with the exception of airfare, which is directly paid by the California Department of Education (CDE).

Selection and Appointment Process

Following the application deadline, the SBE Screening Committee will only consider those applications received that are complete, with all required documents. The committee will review those applications holistically and select candidates to be interviewed. Following the interviews, one candidate will be appointed by the SBE to be the 2025–2026 IQC Student Member. The decision of the Screening Committee is final. Applicants will neither receive a written evaluation of their interview performance nor will their application be returned. All applications, including letters of recommendation, will be available for public inspection and will be considered public records. Personal contact information will be removed.

About the Instructional Quality Commission

The IQC, formerly known as the Curriculum Development and Supplemental Materials Commission, was established in 1927 as an advisory body to the SBE. Education Code Section 60204 (amended 2011) defines the duties of the IQC. The IQC is responsible for advising the SBE on matters related to curriculum and instruction. The IQC (1) develops and recommends curriculum frameworks; (2) develops and recommends criteria for evaluating instructional materials submitted for adoption; (3) evaluates instructional materials that have been submitted by publishers and makes recommendations to adopt or reject each submission; (4) recommends policies and activities to the SBE, the CDE, and local educational agencies regarding curriculum and instruction; and (5) advises and makes recommendations to the SBE on implementing the state's academic content standards. *California Code of Regulations*, Title 5, sections 9511 and 9512 require the SBE to appoint separate committees to assist the IQC in developing curriculum frameworks, developing evaluation criteria for instructional materials, and reviewing instructional materials.
