## What Data Will Be Used for the 2024 Dashboard?



The 2024 California School Dashboard (Dashboard) reflects a full return of California's accountability system with the reporting of Status (current year data), Change (the difference from prior year data), and performance levels (or colors) for all state indicators. The table below identifies each state indicator and the data that will be used to calculate Status and Change.

Note that all state indicator data published by the California Department of Education (CDE) reflects the most current data available.
